CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE:

Dear Friends,

I am sure most of us enjoyed some sort of vacation during the summer months. While I was away on vacation I had the opportunity to visit Niagara Falls. I have never been there so I was happy to experience something new. It met my expectations on the natural beauty of the Falls. A short ride up from the Falls I discovered Niagara University, a Catholic University which was founded by the Vincentian Fathers. As I came across a brochure about the university it stated some famous people who attended the University throughout its history. Low and behold I discovered that Venerable Michael McGivney attended the seminary that is attached to the university. The brochure states this about Fr. McGivney:

"The Knights of Columbus have a connection to Niagara University, thanks to a former seminarian, the Rev. Michael McGivney, founder of the organization. The Connecticut native arrived at the seminary at the start of the academic year in 1871 to study classical languages, among other subjects, before pursuing theological studies elsewhere. Since its founding, in 1882, as a fraternal benefit society to help immigrant families facing the loss of their breadwinners, the Knights have grown to more than 12,000 local units worldwide. Father McGivney died in 1890 at the age of 38, had his cause for sainthood introduced to the Congregation for the Causes of Saints at the Vatican in 2000."

What Fr. McGivney was taught at Niagara University Seminary helped him to lay the ground work for the Knights of Columbus. As September begins and students go back to school it helps us to reflect on two things during this month. First, we thank God for Catholic schools and education, and pray that they may strengthen and continue. Second, like Fr. McGivney and Niagara University, let us think about our own education and schooling and who formed us throughout our years of school, whatever schooling we may have had. Let us pray for those who have educated us and pray that we may teach by word and more importantly, by example.
