Chaplain's Reflection

(Fr. Dermot was not able to submit a message this month, but we hope he will be back next month providing his insights)

Last month, we celebrated the Feast of St. Thomas More, an English Martyr. He was a lawyer and well-respected Lord Chancellor of England under Henry VIII. However, he would not yield to Henry on the issues of Henry's divorce and of his schism with the Church of Rome after Henry established the Church of England. Although Thomas had always been fiercely loyal to Henry, he felt that he could no longer support the King and resigned as Chancellor. Henry desperately wanted Thomas' support, because Thomas was known as a devout and wise man. When it was clear that this support would not come. Thomas was convicted of treason and executed. When he was brought to the place of execution, he told the crowd: "I die the King's good servant, but God's first."

In these times of attacks on religious freedom and in particular the Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus are at the forefront of the struggle to defend the Faith. We will not likely be faced with execution, but our faith will be tested. Like Henry, different sides will want the support of Catholics until there is a conflict with Church teachings that cannot be overcome. We must rely on God for the strength to face these challenges, and rely on our fellow Knights for support. As Knights, we must place loyalty to God before anything else. We must be God's servants before all.
