As you are keenly aware, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused unprecedented impacts to the operation of St. John's Council and its fundraising abilities, which means it has severely impacted our ability to do charitable works and help others. Without events like Irish Night, Shake the Can, Special Children's Dance, Friday Night Socials, etc. the Council's fiscal condition is precarious. It appears we are nearing a point where we are turning a corner towards recovering our normal routines or adjusting to a "new" normal. The fact remains that there are many people less fortunate than us who benefit from the generosity of St. John's Council's members, families, and friends and who still need our help. Therefore, for the month of May we are kicking off a virtual **Bridge to Recovery Fundraising Drive**.

What can you do? I am asking you to do two things. First, please donate whatever you can by visiting www.charity.gofundme.com/KofC1345. I am asking all who read this to please consider making a donation that at a minimum would be equivalent to attending one of our events (\$35-\$50), but even \$5 or \$10 helps. Secondly, please share the flyer and link for the Bridge to Recovery Drive with your friends and family, and explain to them all the good the Knights of Columbus do and what we mean to you, and ask them to contribute whatever they can as well. Think of it like shaking a can for the Knights. If we all do this, our Council will emerge from this pandemic as strong and healthy as possible.

In April 2014, Pope Francis gave a beautiful catechesis on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Update on Council/Columbian Club Closure

Given that the State of NJ has extended school closures to May 15th, and many other orders remain in effect through the end of May, it appears our closure will be extended to at least June 1. When the time does arrive to reopen, I am expecting that it will be a new experience for us all possibly involving additional disinfection practices, social distancing, and seeing each other with masks. While we are anxious to get back to business, we will only do it when we feel we can do it safely for all involved.

Next Council Meeting

Our next Council meeting will be held on Monday May 18th at 8PM via Zoom, a videoconferencing platform. Approximately a week before the meeting I will email the invitation for our meeting. It is a new experience for us all, so I ask for your patience and cooperation.

2020-21 Columbian Year Elections

Because of the restrictions on in-person gatherings our elections will be very different this year. This is another direction coming from Supreme Council and State Council.

Our election process would typically involve a Nominating Committee, Announcement of the Slate, and an in-person election consisting of a call for nominations from the floor and then an election. Because we will not be able to gather in person, we cannot logistically have nominations from the floor followed by an electronic election. Therefore we will have a Nominating Committee that will recommend a slate, but we will also have a call for Nominations (described below). If there are any nominations submitted, those names will appear on the ballots along with the slate recommended by the Nominating Committee, and an election will be carried out electronically via email. I have appointed Trustee Steve Martin, PGK as Chair of this year's Nominating Committee.

The requirement to be an Officer is you must be a 3rd Degree member, or have ben Exemplified with the new Charity, Unity, and Fraternity Degree. Deadline to receive Nominations is May 31, 2020.
